The City of Norton (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Southside Neighborhood Improvements Project – Phase I - Streets

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **City of Norton Offices** located at **618 Virginia Ave. NW, Norton, Virginia 24273**, until **Tuesday, October 18, 2022**, at **2:00 P.M.** local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

The base bid construction of approximately 12,055 square yards (S.Y.) of Type SM-9.5A (1.5 in) asphalt resurfacing, 13 CG-12 curb ramps w/ detectable warning surfaces, 6 CG-9D standard entrance gutters, 55 linear feet (L.F.) of CG-6 curb and gutter, 50 square feet (S.F.) of concrete sidewalk and associated appurtenances.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract for each individual Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis. The Project is funded through the **Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development**.
