Water System Improvements Project – Additional Lines

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Woodway Water Authority Offices** located at **133 Ben Lawson Drive, Pennington Gap, Virginia 24277**, until **Thursday, March 2, 2023**, at **2:00 P.M.** local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Includes the base bid construction of approximately 635 Linear Feet (L.F.) of 6-inch waterline, 2,658 L.F. of 4-inch waterline, 590 L.F. of 2-inch waterline, 700 L.F. of 1-inch waterline, 2,100 L.F. of 3/4" waterline, 3 gate valves, 4 blow-off valves, 2 air release valves, 1 fire hydrant, 20 water meters assemblies and reconnections and associated appurtenances.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract for each individual Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis. The Project is funded through the **USDA Rural Development**

The following waivers apply to this Contract: *De Minimis*, Minor Components and Pig iron and direct reduced iron.
