Beaver Creek Interceptor Rehabilitation Project – Phase 1

General Notice

BVU Authority (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Beaver Creek Interceptor Rehabilitation Project – Phase 1 (Project ID: 2107)

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **BVU Authority Administrative Office** located at **15022 Lee Highway, Bristol, Virginia 24202**, until **March 14, 2023**, at **2:00 p.m.** local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Installation of UV-cured CIPP liner throughout approximately 18,795 LF of sewer line (ranging in size from 8" to 36" diameter) and 308 LF of UV-cured CIPP private lateral sewer lines, with 41 connection rehabilitations of lateral line to main line. Removal and replacement of 96 existing manhole frames and covers with new watertight frames and covers throughout the CIPP lined region, the rehabilitation of approximately 880 VF of sewer manholes, and locating and raising 9 manholes at locations shown in plans.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: **Beaver Creek Interceptor Rehabilitation Project - Phase 1

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract for each individual Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis. The Project is funded through the **Virginia Department of Environmental Quality**.

Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

American Iron and Steel

The following waivers apply to this Contract: *De Minimis*, Minor Components and Pig iron and direct reduced iron.
